- 10:1 ratio- Positives v Negative Behaviours






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Excellent behaviour

Attendance- Parent/Carer expectations:

- · Make sure their child attends everyday on time
- Contact the school to report their child's absence before 8:30am on the day of the absence via telephone messages, Class Charts or email <u>attendance@highamlaneschool.co.uk</u> informing school of the reason for absence when they are expected to return. This must also be done on each subsequent day of absence.
