National Exam Results: The latest national data for GCSE and A Level results is out, and we are thrilled to share our fantastic achievements.

GCSE: Higham Lane School is ranked 299th out of 4181 secondary schools in the UK, placing us approximately in the top 7% nationally. We achieved a Progress 8 score of +0.6, which is well above average, meaning the average student is achieving 6/10 of a grade higher on average in every subject than similar students nationally. This is the highest Progress 8 score our school has ever achieved!

Our Attainment 8 score is 54, compared to the England average of 45.9 and the Warwickshire average of 47.5. Additionally, 64.5% of our students achieved a grade 5 or above in English and Maths at GCSE, compared to the England average of 45.9% and the Warwickshire average of 48.5%. This demonstrates the hard work and dedication of both our students and staff.

A Level: Our A Level results are equally impressive, with an average point score of 36.51 (equivalent to an average grade of B-). The average point score in England is 35.29, and the average in Warwickshire for state-funded schools is 35.15. We are also delighted that 28.3% of all grades at A Level last year were A* or A, and 58.5% of all grades were A*, A, or B. These are also the best results the school has ever achieved! Well done to our amazing Year 11 and Year 13 students from last year! Thank you also to our incredible staff who worked so hard to support our students, we look forward to more success from our current Year 11 and Year 13 students in the summer.

Computer Science House Winners: A special congratulations to Evie F and Andy H for their outstanding achievements in Computer Science. Their dedication and hard work have been exemplary, and they have set a high standard for their peers.



HLS Carol Service: I had the privilege of attending the school carol service on Tuesday evening at St Nicolas Church. It was a wonderful evening filled with festive cheer and excellent performances by our students. A big thank you to our music and drama staff for their hard work in putting the show together, I am also looking forward to the HLS Christmas Concert in Coombe Hall next Tuesday, which promises to be another fantastic event.



Football Success: On Wednesday, I had the privilege of watching our Y10 boys' football team at the Bedworth Oval as they beat Fairfax School 5–2 in the 5th round of the national cup. This victory puts us in the last 32 schools nationwide! Well done to our amazing Y10 footballers and to Mr Bottrill and Mr Wilson for their expert coaching.



Y11 SPE: Thank you to everyone who attended the Y11 online parents' evening on Thursday. We hope our Y11 students and parents/carers found the feedback useful as our students move towards their GCSE exams in just a few months' time. We have the Y10 and 12 SPEs next week, and we look forward to those being equally successful.

Vaping: Please be aware that we are trialling vape detectors in the toilets to ensure no students are vaping and all students are safe at school. The government will be banning the use and selling of vapes across the whole country in 2025 due to health concerns, including popcorn lung, nicotine addiction and damage to teeth and gums.
