#### National Teaching Assistants Day:



Today is National Teaching Assistants Day, and we are truly blessed to have such an amazing team of learning support staff here at Higham Lane. A special thank you to Mrs Taylor, our fantastic new SENCO, and our dedicated teaching assistants who work tirelessly to support students who need a bit of extra help in lessons and around school. Their hard work and care make a significant difference to the lives of many of our students, and we are incredibly grateful for everything they do.

#### European Day of Languages:

On Thursday, we celebrated European Day of Languages with assemblies throughout the week, highlighting the many benefits of learning a language, even just a few words or phrases! Language skills can open so many doors, and we want our students to understand how helpful these skills can be in their future. A huge thank you to Mrs Finley for leading the assemblies, which have been very well received by both students and staff. Thank you also to tutors for leading activities on the subject of languages and to the canteen for providing a range of foreign foods from around the world on Thursday for our students to enjoy.

## GCSE Progress 8 Results:

I am absolutely thrilled to announce that the unvalidated Progress 8 data for our Year 11 GCSE results last year has just been released by an external company; it indicates that our Progress 8 score is likely to be around +0.62, meaning on average, Year 11 students achieved just under two thirds of a grade higher than expected in every subject. This is absolutely incredible and is the highest Progress 8 score the school has ever achieved and is a testament to the hard work of our students and staff. It is an incredible achievement that reflects the excellent teaching and learning happening here every day. This will be one of the highest Progress 8 scores of all schools in Warwickshire. Additionally, approximately 83% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in English and Maths, putting us among the highest-performing non-selective state schools in Warwickshire. We are extremely proud of our students, as these results will open doors for them in the next stage of their education. A huge thank you to our dedicated staff for their unwavering support in helping our students reach their full potential.

#### **Student Services Door:**

Unfortunately, we have a technical fault with the door by Student Services. Until the door can be repaired, all visitors, including parents dropping off children should report to the main reception via Shanklin Gate. Student Services will be temporarily closed to visitors, and we appreciate your understanding as we work to resolve this issue.

## Visitor Feedback:

This week, we had a visitor from another high-performing school who conducted a learning walk around our school. He was incredibly impressed by the high standard of teaching and learning, the excellent behaviour and attitudes of our students, and the quality of their uniform. It is always encouraging to receive such positive feedback from fellow professionals in similar settings to us.

## Year 7 Lunch Changes:

As of Monday 30th September, Year 7 students will no longer have an early lunch and will join the other year groups at the normal lunchtime. This early lunch arrangement was a temporary measure to help them settle into secondary school life, and we are pleased to see how well they have adjusted.

## **Attendance Update:**

There is a strong link between good attendance and positive outcomes for students. We are proud that our attendance remains above the national average, but we are always looking to improve further. The more students are in school, the more likely they are to reach their full potential in both their exams and future careers. Thank you to Mrs Taylor, our Attendance Lead and Mr Williams, our Attendance Champion for their hard work, and to all of you for supporting your child's attendance.

## Year 7 Meet the Tutor and Curriculum Evening:

A huge thank you to all the parents and carers who attended the Year 7 Meet the Tutor and the Year 7/8 Curriculum and Support Evening on Thursday. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive, and it has been wonderful to hear how supported and informed you feel. Thank you to all the staff who made these events such a success.
