





























































A beautiful and sensitive exploration of the experience of child poverty.

Follows the story of a young boy going into year 6, dealing with a failing friendship, an ill younger brother and his own mental demons. *Verse novel




Sami and Ali set out to prone that their friend, Aadam is innocent when he is accused of stealing money from a rich friend's house.


In the world of the Vanquishers, vampires were history...until now.

A young Chinese girl now living in America works hard to help her parents make enough money to live but harbours dreams to become a writer.




A young girl starts high school and struggles when her friendship group changes and she wants to find her own identity

A young boy who survived the Nazi concentration camps arrives in the Lake District, where hopes of a new life await.




Two young girls aboard the SS Titanic try to solve a mystery among the passengers, unaware that time is running out.

A teenage girl has to negogiate the typical traumas of high school, boys and friendships whilst enduring continuous dental treatments.






A fairy-tale story of friendship, belonging and bravery, in an adventure through a winter wonderland.



Follows Kai, a young boy who blames himself for something that tore his family apart.




A twist of fate leads eleven year old Frank to inherit his grandma's fortune, with the condition he use the money to look after the grandfather he has never met
